Guidelines for Awarding

West End Men's Association Scholarships

Applications must be from the Buhl-Castleford Area

SCHOLARSHIPS ARE LIMITED TO PERSONS ATTENDING OR PLANNING TO ATTEND A COLLEGE OR UNIVERSITY OR TECHNICAL SCHOOL IN IDAHO

Applicants must be graduating seniors from high schools or adults from the west end of Twin Falls County planning to attend a college or technical school in Idaho.

The West End Men's Association has some scholarships "ear marked" exclusively for applicants who plan to enroll in post high school agricultural or agriculture related programs. Frequently there are no applications for these "ag" or "ag-related" scholarships. If your major is in/or related to agriculture be sure to indicate that in the appropriate section of the application. Preference in the award of WEMA scholarships is also given to applicants demonstrating financial need.

Neatness, completeness, and coherent, well thought out answers do make a difference in determining who will receive a WEMA scholarship. Take some time and put a little effort into filling out this application- It could earn you at least \$500 to help pay for college expenses!

Applications must be complete and neatly filled out and signed. A current transcript of the applicant's high school or college grades must be included in order to be considered for a scholarship award.

When a scholarship is awarded, the money will be transmitted directly to the institution where the awardee is attending or planning to attend. The awardee's account at the institution will be credited. Failure to attend will result in revocation of the scholarship. College and tech school students may apply and recipients of WEMA scholarships are eligible to reapply for a continuation scholarship during their college/tech school careers.

All scholarships applications are due by April 1. Completed applications should be submitted to Vince Hamilton at the Buhl branch of Farmers National Bank.
