

LIONS SCHOLARSHIP



BACKGROUND: In December of 1994, a new Scholarship Lions Club was formed in Southern Idaho. The primary purpose of this Scholarship Lions Club is to provide financial assistance to college students.

The Scholarship Lions Club of District 39 will present the winner of this scholarship \$1000 to further their education. The money for this fund is raised each year by the club.

One-half of the scholarship money will be given for the first term and then the second half will be given for the second term. When the student is ready to pay fees in the fall, all they need to do is contact the Secretary of the Scholarship Lions Club and a check made out to the student and the college will be sent directly to the college. The phone number of the Secretary of the Lions Club will be provided with the Scholarship Award Letter which will be presented near the time of high school graduation. This scholarship must be used during the next school year following the presentation of the scholarship.

APPLICATION:

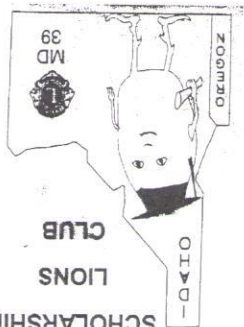
It should be completed and returned to the high school office by April 15th.

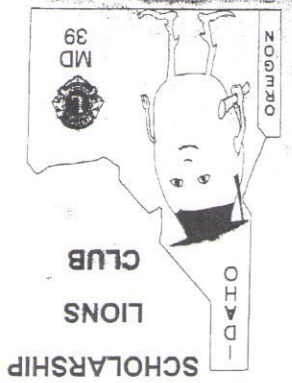
